

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-15

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN ENERGY EFFICIENT SCHOOLS INITIATIVE
LOAN AGREEMENT WITH THE TENNESSEE ENERGY EFFICIENT SCHOOLS COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Energy Efficient Schools Council is willing to provide grant and loan funds to the Weakley County Board of Education through its Energy Efficient Schools Initiative (EESI) program to fund a project to increase energy efficiency in the Weakley County School System; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of Education desires to enter into the attached Loan Agreement with the Tennessee Energy Efficient School Council. The loan is in the amount of \$1,619,714 at 1% interest for a period of 120 months; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to upgrade lighting at schools and reduce utility costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in reconvened session on this the 21st day of November, 2016 that the Weakley County Board of Education is authorized to participate in the Tennessee Energy Efficient Schools Council Grant and Loan Program as described in the attached agreement and the County Mayor and County Clerk are authorized to sign and execute the proper loan documents when they become available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
