**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-06
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE
DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE
SMALL CITIES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM/CDBG FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017.**

WHEREAS, the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, having committed itself to the improvement of the community that it represents, wishes to make application for the construction of a new Carl Perkins Child Abuse Prevention facility; and


WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility by CDBG program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$315,000 in grant funds to implement the aforementioned improvements and will commit funds in the amount of \$435,316 to be provided by the Carl Perkins Center for the Prevention of Child Abuse, to constitute a total project cost of \$750,316.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in session on this the 27th day of July, 2017 that the Mayor of Weakley County is authorized to sign an application for CDBG funds, to commit local matching funds to the proposed project, and to sign all necessary assurances, agreements or contracts required for recipients of CDBG funds.




