**Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments
To The General Purpose School Fund
For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2018**

WHEREAS, amendments need to be made in the General Purpose Special Education Program to include additional revenue from the State for reimbursement of high cost expenditures for IDEA students that occurred in the 2016-17 school year with the addition of expenditure transfers.


