**Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN
Drug Control Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2018**

WHEREAS, the purchase of a new vehicle for the Weakley County Sheriff's Department is necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the use of the vehicle will allow Weakley County Officers to protect Weakley County citizens and aid in the identification and arrest of drug offenders, as well as equipping additional vehicles with the necessary enhancements, technologies, and safety mechanisms required for officer responsibilities; and,

WHEREAS, drug control funds are available for the purchase of a new vehicle and such enhancements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of November, 2017 that:
