Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2018

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Fund Budget for the FY 2017-18 is in need of realignment in estimated expenditures due to the fact that Weakley County has been awarded a grant from the State of Tennessee for courtroom security. As a requirement of the grant, the county is responsible for 10% of the total project cost. The county's portion will be funded from the courtroom security reserve fund, and proceeds of the grant will be used to purchase video arraignment equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 19th day of March, 2018 that:

SECTION 1: The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:
