**Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN
General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020**

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Fund budget for 2019-2020FY is in need of realignment to allow new monies to be budgeted for the purchase of new computer equipment for the Weakley County Election Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of the equipment has been made available through the Help Americans Vote Again (HAVA) Act; and,

WHEREAS, the total expense to purchase the new computer equipment is \$1,838; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 16th day of September, 2019 that:






