

Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN
General Purpose School Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Purpose School Fund Budget for the FY 2019-20 is in need of realignment to include revenue from state-awarded school safety grants and the corresponding expenditures, as well as the need for realignment to include additional revenue awarded to Weakley County through the State of Tennessee's Safe Schools Act grant, additional local matching funds, and corresponding expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of November, 2019, that:
