Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN
General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020

WHEREAS, Weakley County Government wishes to apply for a Community-Oriented Connectivity Broadband Grant Program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Utilities Service and has entered into a formal partnership with WK&T Telecommunications; and,

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the grant, WK&T has provided a community center to give county residents free access to computer terminals and wi-fi internet; and,

WHEREAS, Weakley County has agreed to staff the community center, which must be open for 40 hours each week to the public before, during, and after normal working hours, as well as a day on the weekend to best address the specific needs of our community as outlined in the grant requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of November, 2019, that:


SECTION 1: The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:




