RESOLUTION NO. 2020-44

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (EDA) CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

WHEREAS, the legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, having committed itself to the improvement of the community that it represents, wishes to authorize West Kentucky and Tennessee Telecommunications Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter "WK&T") to make application for the purpose of providing broadband access to an unserved area of Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility by United States Economic Development Administration's program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$2,000,000 in grant funds to implement the aforementioned improvements and will commit funds in the amount of \$2,000,000 to be provided by WK&T and \$2,000,000 provided by Weakley County Government.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in session on this the 26th day of May, 2020, that the Mayor of Weakley County is authorized to sign an application for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act for Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Funds, to commit local matching funds to the proposed project, and to sign all necessary assurances, agreements, or contracts required for recipients of these funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
