**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-24
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY WAIVER OF BUILDING PERMIT FEES
FOR PROPERTIES DAMAGED BY ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS IN WEAKLEY
COUNTY, TENNESSEE ON DECEMBER 10, 2021**

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2021, tornadoes occurred in portions of Weakley County resulting in substantial property damage; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County Government has determined that it is in the best interest of the public and in support of the of the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens that building permit fees be temporarily waived for the construction or other work required to repair or replace damage arising from the adverse weather conditions that occurred on December 10, 2021, in Weakley County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County Government finds it is in the public interest to authorize the temporary waiver of fees associated with the work to repair or replace said losses, in order to encourage the quick and efficient recovery, repair, and replacement of said damage;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in session on this the 18th day of January, 2022, authorizes the Weakley County Trustee to waive building permit fees for any application received and issued from January 19, 2022, through December 31, 2022, as set forth in the Private Acts of Weakley County Government for those properties damaged as a result of the tornadoes that occurred on December 10, 2021 in Weakley County, Tennessee.
