**I. CALL TO ORDER – APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**Resolution No. 2025-44 Resolution Authorizing a Road Addition for the Weakley County Highway Department for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025:** Commissioner Hopper made a motion to place the resolution on the floor for discussion. Commissioner Freeman seconded. Weakley County Road Supervisor, Jeff Cosby was recognized. Supervisor Cosby explained there is a helicopter pad on Scarbrough Lane that is currently gravel. The road is used by emergency personal. Supervisor Cosby would like to add Scarbrough Lane to the road list so that it can be paved and maintained for the emergency personal to be able to access the helicopter pad more easily. The resolution passed unanimously.

**Resolution No. 2025-45 Resolution Authorizing a 2025 County Maintenance Road List:**

Commissioner Hazlewood made a motion to place the resolution on the floor for discussion. Commissioner Freeman seconded. Weakley County Road Supervisor, Jeff Cosby was recognized. No roads were removed from the list but one road was added. The resolution passed unanimously.

**Update on State Aid Programs Progress:**

Weakley County Road Supervisor, Jeff Cosby advised there was no statewide funding for bridges at this time. There are five (5) bridges he would like to get funding to update. Supervisor Cosby does currently have \$2.9 million in state aid funding for hot mix that is to be used by May 31, 2025.

Seeing no other business, Commissioner Doster made a motion to adjourn at 9:11 a.m.


