I. CALL TO ORDER – APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairperson Westbrook called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and called for the consideration of the minutes from the previous meeting which was held on May 6, 2024. Commissioner Doster made the motion to approve. A second was by Commissioner Hazlewood, and the minutes passed unanimously.

III. NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 2025-08 Resolution Authorizing A Road Addition For The Weakley County Highway Department For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025: Commissioner Hopper made a motion to place the resolution on the floor and with a second from Commissioner Eddings the resolution was opened for discussion. Commissioner Westbrook recognized Road Supervisor Jeff Cosby. Supervisor Cosby stated that a citizen contacted him who is building a house on this road and would like to have an address. Supervisor Cosby said the road is in good shape. This will be the only house on the road and there are grain bins at the end. The resolution passed unanimously, and Radford Lane was added to the Road Maintenance List.

Discussion of Road Addition and Closure Forms: Commissioner Westbrook presented a form that he would like to propose as the new standard procedure for requesting a road closure or addition. He stated that due to additional requirements for road additions and closures, he is recommending the use of this form. The committee was agreeable to this.


IV. OTHER BUSINESS

Commissioner Westbrook asked Supervisor Cosby about his current progress in the State Aid Road project. Supervisor Cosby stated that he is currently attempting to contract and bid out eight miles of hot mix to pave roads including King Road in Martin, Hunt Road in Martin, Ryan Road in Martin. Supervisor Cosby stated that he will be adding a timeline stipulation to the bid process and thinks he will make the deadline for the projects either at the beginning or end of October.

Seeing no other business, Commissioner Doster made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Freeman seconded and with that the meeting was adjourned at 9:11 a.m.


